The main objectives of the EERA JP ES mobility scheme it to:

- **reinforce collaboration** within JP ES in order to realise new breakthrough energy storage solutions
- **increased understanding** and deepening research relationships
- support the young researchers (students, PhD students, researchers within 5 years after completing a doctorate) in their carrier developing
- enhance **consortia** building within the JP ES

FINANCIAL SUPPORT:

- Travel costs: 500 €
- Accomodation costs: 250 €/week
- Daily rate: not provided by the mobility scheme
- Duration: i.e. max 12 weeks

MOBILITY SCHEME PLAN:

1. The applicant fills out an application form (available here) and sends it to the Exchange Coordinator (eera-jpes@sci.kit.edu)
2. The members of Management Board of JP evaluate the application
3. If the evaluation is positive, a contract is signed between the applicant, the host organisation and the Exchange Coordinator.
4. After the exchange, a report on the exchange will be published on the EERA JP ES website and a presentation summarising the exchange will be given during the JP ES Steering Committee meeting.

NEXT STEPS

1. CALL for PROPOSALS: 1st June 2020 – 31st July 2020
2. EVALUATION: Decisive Committee (part of MB) evaluates the applications (August 2020)
3. ORGANISATION ACTIVITIES: September 2020/October 2020
4. RESEARCH EXCHANGE:
 - **START: 1st November 2020 (at the earliest) – 1st May 2021 (at the latest)**
 - **END: 30 Jan 2021 (at the earliest) – 31st July (at the latest)**
5. REPORT to be presented either at SCM-18 (Spring 2021) or SCM-19 (Autumn 2021)
